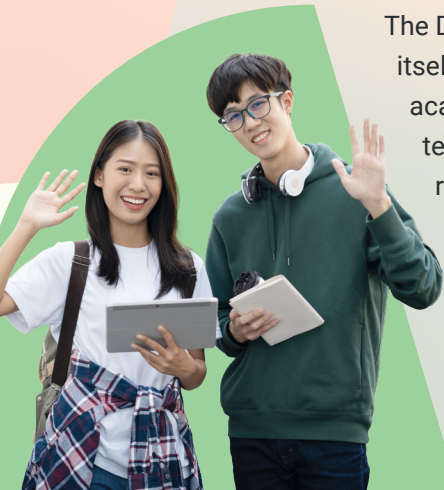

The Department of Social and Behavioural Sciences prides itself on a long track record in offering quality learning in academic programmes delivered by a multi-disciplinary team of brilliant and committed scholars who bring real-world experience into the learning environment.

The Department currently offers 8 academic programmes at the undergraduate and postgraduate level. In total we have approximately 1,800 enrolled students. We also have a PhD group of 45 students pursuing research under the supervision of faculty members who specialise in a wide array of fields and disciplines in the social sciences.

The Bachelor of Social Sciences in Psychology programme provides students with comprehensive training in psychology with an emphasis on experimental and research competencies, and prepares students for professional development in human service careers and advanced training in professional psychology and related fields. This is one of the CityUHK's Flagship Programmes, which equip students with essential knowledge and skills, cultivate their global leadership abilities, and connect them with leading professionals.



The Programme Provides

Strong theoretical & scientific training in psychological studies

Individual research project in the final year to work with a faculty member

Lab-based training in eye-tracking system, EEG system, tDCS and TMS system

Opportunities to work on empirical research under academic staff (e.g. voluntary research schemes)

Joint Bachelor's Degree Programme in Psychology



The Joint Bachelor's Degree Programme (JBDP) includes 12 four-year joint-degree programmes, including the Bachelor of Social Sciences in Psychology, offered by CityUHK, and the corresponding Bachelor degree in Psychology, offered by Columbia University.

Students from Hong Kong and around the world can apply directly for Year 1 entry to the elite JBDP. Outstanding normative four-year degree students enrolled at CityUHK BSocSc Psychology programme are also eligible to apply during their second year at CityUHK.

BSocSc Crime Science

Crime Science is an interdisciplinary approach for developing practical solutions to real world crime problems. This programme aims to equip students with a comprehensive understanding of this approach, including the use of scientific theories, methods and strategies for preventing crime. Students will have the opportunity to contribute to societal progress through innovative approaches. The programme considers the prevention of many forms of both small-scale and transnational organised criminal activity – ranging from residential burglaries to cybercrime. It is ideally suited for practical-minded students with a passion for discovery and a commitment to utilizing scientific analytical methods to benefit society and promote social development.

BSocSc Crime Science and Bachelor of Laws (Double Degree)

The Bachelor of Laws (LLB) degree is a recognised qualification for admission to the Postgraduate Certificate in Laws (PCLL), a prerequisite for entering the legal profession in Hong Kong. Students of the Crime Science and Laws double degree will procure knowledge and skills necessary to undertake managerial and executive responsibilities in a wide range of professions, including policing, crime prevention, security services, correctional services, conflict resolution, and the operation of non-governmental organizations. Many opportunities will be provided for students to develop an interest in discovery and innovation to benefit society through crime control and reduction. The skill set taught in the double degree enables students to apply for jobs in the government, disciplinary forces and private corporations. CityUHK is the only UGC-funded institution that offers a double degree in Crime Science and Laws in Hong Kong. We bring together our legal and Crime Science experts to provide students with a valuable learning experience.

BSocSc Social Work

The Bachelor of Social Sciences in Social Work (BSSSW) programme is a helping professional degree that is accredited by the Social Workers Registration Board (SWRB) to promote human and community well-being, with a commitment to upholding human dignity, social equality, and diversity. The programme aims to enable students to evaluate and align personal values with the value base of the social work profession, and acquire knowledge, skills, understanding, and practice competence in the profession. Throughout the course of study, students will receive solid foundation training in social sciences and social work related to their professional practice. Prior to integrating classroom learning into real life practice through two fieldwork placements, students will undergo rigorous theoretical and laboratory training in the classroom.
